ADVICE LETTER NO. 1404

TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Pursuant to General Order 96-B, California-American Water Company (“California American Water”) (U210W) hereby submits for review this advice letter, including tariff sheets applicable to California American Water’s service areas.

Background:

California American Water files this advice letter to incorporate the recently acquired Bellflower Municipal Water System (“Bellflower MWS”) into authorized rates. This request is consistent with the Bellflower MWS Settlement Agreement adopted in Decision (“D.”) 22-10-003 and the 2019 General Rate Case (“GRC”) Settlement Agreement adopted in D.21-11-018. With this advice letter the Bellflower MWS will be consolidated into rates for California American Water’s Southern Division. Further, consistent with the 2019 GRC Settlement Agreement a portion of the approved Bellflower MWS rate base is allocated statewide in California American Water’s Northern and Central Divisions. Additionally, through this filing California American Water would incorporate Bellflower into its Customer Assistance Program (“CAP”) where income eligible customers would be able to enroll and receive a discount on their bill.

Discussion:

In September of 2018 California American Water filed Application (“A.”) 18-09-013 requesting the approval of the sale of Bellflower MWS assets to California American Water. While that proceeding was still pending, California American Water filed its 2019 GRC A.19-07-004 to establish authorized rates for the period 2021-2023. In the 2019 GRC filing, California American Water requested to incorporate the Bellflower MWS into rates with the expectation that the Bellflower MWS acquisition would be approved prior to the start of the 2021 Test Year. The proposed ratemaking integration was described in the Direct Testimony of Stephen (Wes) Owens.¹ The proposed integration included inclusion of incremental operating expenses and a request to normalize the authorized rate base of Bellflower MWS by partially spreading the acquisition cost statewide.

In early 2021, multiple parties to the 2019 GRC entered into the 2019 GRC Settlement Agreement.² This settlement resolved all disputed issues between signatories. Amongst other issues, this settlement adopted California American Water’s operating expense estimates for acquired systems³ and approved the California American Water’s Special Request #11: Acquisition Revenue Requirement Normalization,⁴ which would allow for the statewide allocation of a portion of rate base for acquisitions identified in the 2019 GRC. At the time 2019 GRC

Settlement was executed, the Bellflower MWS acquisition was still pending approval before the CPUC. Recognizing that the outcome of that proceeding was uncertain, parties to the 2019 GRC Settlement agreed to remove the Bellflower MWS acquisition from rates incorporated into the settlement, but included provisions recognizing that if the Bellflower MWS acquisition was subsequently approved, California American Water may file a Tier 2 advice letter to incorporate approval into authorized rates as originally proposed in the 2019 GRC.⁵ The 2019 GRC Settlement was ultimately approved by the CPUC in November of 2021 by D.21-11-018.⁶

In November of 2021, California American Water and the Public Advocates Office executed the Bellflower Settlement Agreement⁷ resolving all disputed issues in A.18-09-013. The Bellflower Settlement Agreement established the \$17M purchase price as the rate base at time of acquisition,⁸ recognized that the City of Bellflower agreed to make \$5M immediately available to address post-acquisition capital needs,⁹ that this \$5M should be treated as grant funding for ratemaking purposes upon acquisition close,¹⁰ and authorized California American Water to file a Tier 2 Advice Letter to incorporate Bellflower into authorized rates consistent with the 2019 GRC Settlement.¹¹

The Bellflower Settlement Agreement was adopted by the CPUC in October 2022 in D.22-10-003. The requests contained in this advice letter relate to Ordering Paragraphs (“OP”) 1, 2, 3, and 4 of D.22-10-003, which state:

- 1. The January 22, 2019 amended application of California-American Water Company (Cal-Am) to authorize Cal-Am’s acquisition of the assets of the Bellflower Municipal Water System (Bellflower MWS) from the City of Bellflower (Bellflower) pursuant to the November 27, 2017 Asset Purchase Agreement between Cal-Am and Bellflower (Acquisition) is approved. At the close of the Acquisition, Cal-Am’s rate base shall increase by \$17 million to reflect Cal-Am’s Acquisition of the assets of the Bellflower MWS.*
- 2. The settlement agreement between California-American Water Company and the Public Advocates Office attached to this decision as Attachment 1 is adopted except for Paragraphs 7.1(k) and (l), which are not adopted.*
- 3. The \$5 million commitment by the City of Bellflower (Bellflower) to California-American Water Company (Cal-Am) in the November 1, 2021 Agreement Regarding Water Infrastructure Improvement Funding (Infrastructure Agreement) between Cal-Am and Bellflower is a government grant that shall be accounted for as a contribution under the Uniform System of Accounts. At the close of the acquisition by Cal-Am of the assets of the Bellflower Municipal Water System from Bellflower, Cal-Am’s rate base shall be reduced by \$5 million to reflect Bellflower’s \$5 million Infrastructure Agreement commitment.*

4. *As a result of the rate base adjustments reflected in Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 3, effective at the close of the acquisition by California-American Water Company (Cal-Am) of the assets of the Bellflower Municipal Water System, Cal-Am's rate base shall increase by \$12 million.*

Requests:

This Tier 2 Advice Letter is submitted to incorporate approval for the Bellflower MWS acquisition into authorized rates established in D.21-11-018 as authorized by the 2019 GRC Settlement adopted in D.21-11-018 and the Bellflower MWS Settlement Agreement authorized in D.22-10-003. This ratemaking integration incorporates the following provisions:

1. **Incremental Expenses** – incremental O&M and A&G expenses related to purchased water¹² and purchased power¹³, insurance other than group (IOTG),¹⁴ contracted services,¹⁵ and miscellaneous expenses.¹⁶ Since these expenses are directly related to the operation of the Bellflower MWS they are integrated fully into the Southern Division.
2. **Rate Base** – California American Water's 2019 GRC Application included Special Request #11: Acquisition Revenue Requirement Normalization¹⁷ seeking authorization to normalize the rate base of four acquisitions by spreading the utility plant acquisition adjustment ("UPAA") related to those acquisitions either partially (for Bellflower MWS) or entirely (for Rio Plaza, Fruitridge, and Hillview). This rate base normalization is accomplished by determining the revenue requirement associated with the UPAA and allocating this revenue requirement to each district. For Bellflower MWS, California American Water requested a rate base determination equal to the \$17M full purchase price with \$9,085,000 of the rate base being allocated to the Los Angeles District and \$7,915,000 being allocated statewide.¹⁸ That rate base allocation is incorporated into the Bellflower MWS ratemaking integration.
3. **Bellflower MWS Grant Funding** – As described in the adopted Bellflower MWS Settlement Agreement, the City of Bellflower has made \$5M available to California American Water for addressing costs related to post-acquisition capital improvement to the former Bellflower MWS. Although not received at the acquisition close, that \$5M will be accounted for as if it were grant funding received from the state at the time of the acquisition's close for ratemaking purposes – i.e., amounts made available are to be recognized as contributions when made available, not when improvements are made. This \$5M grant funding is incorporated into the Bellflower MWS ratemaking integration as a reduction to Southern Division rate base.¹⁹
4. **Bellflower MWS Revenues** – Bellflower MWS customer count, customer classification, meter size, and usage information incorporated into the ratemaking integration was provided by the City of Bellflower.

This ratemaking integration results in an overall statewide increase of \$1,107,861, or 0.38%, for California American Water customers, including customers of the recently acquired Bellflower MWS. Proposed revenue increases by Division are provided in the table below.

<u>Division</u>	<u>\$ Increase</u>	<u>% Increase</u>
Northern	\$368,998	0.46%
Central	\$211,437	0.27%

Additionally, through this filing California American Water requests Bellflower customers be incorporated into the CAP. Income eligible customers would be able to enroll in the program and non-CAP customers in Bellflower would receive the CAP surcharge that funds the program.

California American Water requests an effective date of March 19, 2023, or 30 days from the filing date of this Tier 2 advice letter.

California American Water submits this as a Tier 2 advice letter pursuant to D.21-11-018 and D.22-10-003.

Protests and Responses:

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the advice letter. A **protest** objects to the advice letter in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds²⁰ are:

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;

3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;
or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory (provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.)

A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

1. PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Annual Consumption Adjustment Mechanism (“ACAM”) is to adjust rates annually based on the previous year’s actual water consumption in order to stabilize revenues and moderate future Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism (“WRAM”)/Modified Cost Balancing Account (“MCBA”) balances. D.18-05-027, established the ACAM for California American Water’s Monterey Service Area as a pilot program effective January 1, 2019. Per D.21-11-018 the ACAM is a permanent program for the Monterey Service Area and a pilot program for all other service areas to be evaluated in the subsequent GRC.

2. APPLICABILITY:

Applicable to California American Water’s Central, Northern, and Southern Divisions. The Fruitridge Vista, Chualar, and Bellflower service areas are excluded.

3. RATES:

The ACAM annually adjusts volumetric rates based on actual water sales.

4. REGULATORY PROCESS:

- a. California American Water will file a Tier 2 advice letter on or before November 15.
- b. The advice letter will provide actual recorded monthly consumption by classification and by tier from October 1 of the prior year through September 30 of the current year, along with the legal and court ordered production limitations, covered by the ACAM for the applicable service areas in the Northern, Central, and Southern Divisions.
- c. Upon approval of the Tier 2 advice letter, California American Water will file a Tier 1 advice letter to implement new rates January 1 of the subsequent year. The approved data will then replace the adopted quantities beginning January 1 of the subsequent year and be used for future rate adjustments during that year.

5. RATEMAKING PROCEDURE:

California American Water will include ACAM results in implementation of test year and attrition year filings.
