## **EMPLOYEES ENGAGED IN OUR COMMUNITIES**



39 of our team members volunteered more than **520 hours in the community**.

Employees donated **more than 100 books** during Black History Month to benefit the Luna Library, a local library that collects and distributes books with African-American history or character focus.

Our employees hosted a clothing, accessories and stuffed animal drive for children served by the Foster Care Council of Kentucky, filling the trunks of 7 cars.



## **GIVING BACK: MORE THAN \$220,000**

We donated \$151,875 to organizations in our communities through grants, scholarships, general charitable contributions and programming support, and \$74,264 to assist customers in paying their water bill.



**Help to Others Program:** \$74,264 to fund our customer assistance program. Since 2000, we have been assisting customers experiencing financial hardship to help keep their water services flowing. In 2022, 290 grants totaling \$43,314 were provided to households in need.
