Investing in the communities we serve and love is very important to us at West Virginia American Water. We believe when we invest and volunteer at our local schools and nonprofit organizations, we are all stronger. In 2022, we invested more than \$406,500 in communities through general charitable contributions, grants, sponsorships and programming support to approximately 110 organizations. Making an impact across the state is one more way we help keep life flowing!

GIVING BACK: MORE THAN \$406,500

We donated \$294,229 to organizations in our communities through grants, scholarships, general charitable contributions and programming support, and over \$112,303 to assist customers in paying their water or wastewater bill.

Help to Others Program: \$112,303 to fund our customer assistance program. Since 2008, we have been assisting customers experiencing financial hardship to help keep their water and/or wastewater services flowing. In 2022, approximately \$1 million was provided to households in need through the company and government assistance programs.
